Society for Libertarian Life (SLL) will hold its first election convention for nine National Executive Board Officers, four members at large, and five chapter representatives seats on May 9 at the CSULB Student Union.

Members, SLL chapters and affiliates in good standing (paid or recognized by the election board) will be allowed to vote for candidates running for offices which include: Chair, Vice-Chair, Executive Director, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Computer Director, Chapter Director and Fundraiser. Editor of *Libertas Review* will be selected by the new Board at the next meeting.

PROCEDURES AND RULES

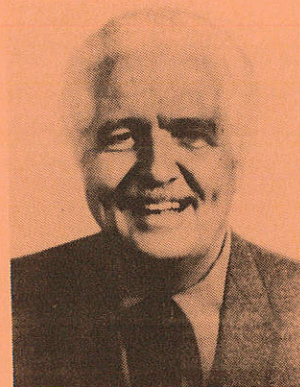
Candidates should file with SLL by May 1, 1981. A candidate may be nominated from the convention floor if put in nomination by an Executive Board member of SLL or 50 percent vote from official delegates.

Eligible members include: (1) members paid up thru May 10, 1981, and (2) members recognized by election board. Official chapters paid up thru May 10, 1981, receive additional votes as a chapter depending on size of membership. Voting rate of chapters and affiliates: 1 to 5 members (belonging to SLL), one vote per chapter; 6 to 10 members, two votes per chapter; 11 to 15 members, three votes per chapter; 16 to 20 members, four votes per chapter; 21 to 30 members, five votes per chapter; 31 to 50 members, eight votes per chapter and 51 to 100 members, ten votes per chapter. In addition to the introduction by Robert LeFevre, agenda includes:

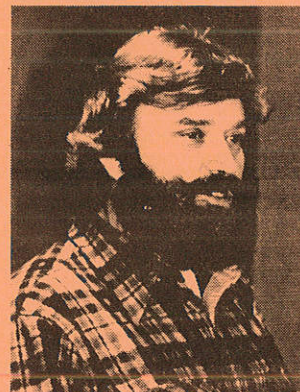
- ★ Roll call to determine eligible delegates.
- ★ Nominations, if any, from the convention floor.
- ★ Short Introduction of candidates.
- ★ Short (2 to 3 min.) speech by candidates.

- ★ Counting votes.
- ★ Declaration of winners.
- ★ Acceptance speech by elected Chair
- ★ Reaffirming the *Libertas* Statement.
