Gary Hudson has been an active participant in the space industrialization field for the past 14 years. In 1980 he started G.C.H., Inc., an engineering research and development corporation based in the San Francisco Bay area, to design and prototype launch vehicle systems for commercial use. Educated in physics and medicine, Hudson has published Beyond Earth: A Personal View of Space Civilization, as well as a textbook on the physics and economics of space transportation systems.

Victor Koman, author of several science-fiction novels, among them Jonuta Rising! and The Carnadyne Horde, (both as "John Cleve") and the forthcoming "theological suspense novel", The Jehovah Contract. Mr. Koman has attended three universities in as many years, cultivating a profound distrust of formal education.

Marc Eric Ely-Chaitlin, has been politically active since the ripe old age of 17, when he began a short-lived movement to incorporate Dana Point as a city; at 19 ran for the City Council of Ashland, Oregan; at 20 joined the Libertarian Party — for only nine months duration after which he decided to withdraw from all partisan politics as he felt were deceptive and divisive. Applying organizational skills with libertarian principles he developed the Free Territory of Ely-Chatelaine, which was founded in December of 1975.

Michael Grossberg, is a journalist who frequently writes about the space movement. Currently a reporter and movie critic at the Victor Valley Daily Press, he previously worked at the Indianapolis News, The Daily Texan and Free Texas. He is the author of the Space Exploration and Unclaimed Property planks in the LP National Platform. In 1982, he founded the Libertarian Futurist Society, which explores free market approaches to space industrialization in its quarterly journal and sponsors the Prometheus Awards honoring pro-freedom fiction. Since 1981, Mr. Grossberg has served as executive director of the Free Press Association. He also has published freelance atricles on a variety of subjects in Science Fiction Review, Laissez Faire Review, Libertarian Review, Private Practice and Reason Magazine.

Walter Patrick, is currently serving as head of council for Glory Road, a decade-old industrial commune dedicated to establishing self-sufficency at sea. The Glory Road commune, which is staffed by a dozen people, has its own foundry and electronic shop.

Charles Curley is a computer programmer specialising in real-time process control and other applications where time is critical. He is the author of Advancing FORTH, a textbook on the programming language FORTH, due out from Computer Science Press this fall. Curley is active in the L-5 Society, for which he organized the 1984 Conference on Space Developement. He is also a founding member of the National Committee to Legalize Gold. He also has authored The Coming Profit in Gold, published by Bantam.

Samuel E. Konkin III, who will take the place of Brad Linawaver on the panel "Libertarian Societies in Modern Fiction," is the editor of *New Libertarian*. Other organizations that Konkin has started include the Movement for a Libertarian Left, The George Orwell Society and New Libertarian Alliance. Considered as one of the leading advocates of the "Counter Economy," Konkin is most devoted to attacking party politics, primarily the Libertarian Party.


