PEARSON & SHAW ACCUSE F.D.A. OF CRIMES AGAINST HUMANITY!

The Placebo And Other Lethal Policies

Durk and Sandy Speak Out at FOFCOn On Saturday, November 8

Durk Pearson and Sandy Shaw, biomedical researchers and authors of the best-selling book *Life Extension: A Practical Scientific Approach*, have announced that they plan to use their appearance at the Future of Freedom Conference November 7, 8 and 9 in Culver City, to continue and publicize a major campaign against the Food and Drug Administration's policy of denying experimental drugs and biomedical technology to terminal patients.

"It may be possible to force the FDA to allow the terminally ill access to experimental drugs made available to them without charge by pharmaceutical companies, giving those individuals a potentially greater chance to survive, and providing far more biomedical information than is being produced under the FDA's current inhumane policies," say Durk and Sandy.

Terminal heart patients, for example—even those who could afford the treatment themselves—are now denied permission to have the Jarvik 7 artificial heart implanted without FDA approval. Only a few selected experimental operations are permitted at a time. Thus patients whose only alternative is death are denied a chance at life by bureaucratic fiat—and the research community is denied the information that would be provided by such implantations whether they were ultimately successful or not.

It is not only heart patients who suffer from the FDA's intransigence. Victims of AIDS and other incurable diseases are denied access to potentially valuable experimental drugs. Under present law, no new drug or medical device can be sold

until it has been approved as both "safe" and "effective" by the FDA. New-drug approval is expensive and routinely take years to complete. As policy analyst Dale Gieringer recently noted in a paper prepared for the Cato Institute: "Unapproved experimental products cannot be given to human subjects except in investigational studies that have been explicitly pre-approved by the FDA through a process known as 'application for investigational new drug (IND) exemption.'"

Because of FDA policy, access to in-

vestigational products is extremely limited. As of April, only 200-300 of an estimated 10,000 known AIDS patients had received investigational drugs. Because AIDS is presently untreatable and invariably lethal (killing 50 percent of victims within a year of diagnosis and all within three years), patients have been willing to try new therapies. The FDA, however, has forbidden this in most cases.

The usual reaction for FDA's reluctance to permit more widespread use of experimental drugs is the desire to do

NORMA JEAN ALMODOVAR—Almodovar is a former Los Angeles Police officer turned professional callgirl and author of *Cop Turned Callgirl*, current Libertarian Party candidate for Lt. Governor of California.

DAVID BERGLAND—Bergland is currently an attorney practicing in Costa Mesa, California and also lectures and delivers workshops on communicating libertarian ideas. In 1983 he was selected as the Libertarian Party's Presidential candidate.

WALTER BLOCK—Dr. Walter Block received his Ph.D. from Columbia University and is Senior Economist at the Fraser Institute in Vancouver, British Columbia and Director of its Centre for the Study of Economics and Religion. A member of numerous organizations and author of *Defending the Undefendable*, and Editor of *Zoning: Its Costs and Relevance, Rent Control: Myths and Realities, Discrimination, Affirmative Action and Equal Opportunity*.

ALAN BOCK—Alan Bock is senior columnist for the *Orange County Register*.

DICK BODDIE—Boddie holds a law degree from Syracuse University and is one of the nation's leading motivational speakers, teaches at UC Irvine and has hosted television and radio programs, including a segment with David Bergland of "Liberty On The Air" produced by Dagny Enterprises.

BARBARA BRANDEN—Ms. Branden is author of *The Passion of Ayn Rand*, a long-time associate of Ayn Rand, Ms. Branden was the managing editor of *The Objectivist*. She has a degree in philosophy from UCLA and New York University.

ED CLARK—A graduate of Harvard Law School, Ed Clark ran for governor of California on the Libertarian Party ticket, winning almost 400,000 votes. In 1980, Clark ran for President of the United States and received over 1 million votes.

LEWIS COLEMAN, M.D.—Dr. Coleman is an anesthesiologist on the staffs at St. Luke's Hospital in Pasadena and San Gabriel Hospital in San Gabriel and as such is well aware of the current dilemma facing physicians in high risk specialties and the insurance industry.

KEVIN CULLINANE—Cullinane operates the Freedom Country seminars in South Carolina. Cullinane is considered the intellectual heir to Robert LeFevre. Many of Cullinane courses are similar to LeFevre's courses on the Nature of Man and Government.

JOHN DENTINGER—Dentinger is a writer, radio commentator and feature writer for *Reason*. His articles have appeared in the *Orange County Register* and *The Los Angeles Times*. He is involved in the Free Press Association.

MARK ERIC ELY-CHATELAINE—Eric Ely-Chatelaine founded the territory of Ely-Chatelaine and became its first king. Mark ran for city council in Ashland, Oregon at age 19 and received 22 percent of the vote. In 1979 he organized the Libertarian Party of San Juan County, Washington. He is a graduate of the University of Science and Philosophy in Virginia.

DON ERNSBERGER—Don holds an M.A. in Economic History from Temple University and is a Ph.D. candidate at Temple. He is currently an instructor of philosophy for the gifted and talented in

Bucks County Pennsylvania and is publisher and co-director of "Individual Liberty" and the Society for Individual Liberty.

MARSHALL FRITZ—Marshall is founder and Chairman of Advocates for Self-Government. Marshall has a B.A. in Business Administration from Cal State Fullerton, worked in computer sales, education and design for I.B.M. and was State Chairman for the Libertarian Party of California.

BOB HALLSTROM—Together with George Gordon, Bob Hallstrom co-founded the Barristers' Inn and pioneered a 90 hour video course on common law to teach people proficiency in obtaining redress for their grievances in the judicial system. There are now 300 active schools in 47 states.

TOM HAZLETT—Hazlett teaches economics at Cal State University at Davis and is the Senior Editor of the *Manhattan Report on Economic Policy*. He has written for such publications as *Reader's Digest, The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, Chicago Tribune, Reason* and *The Los Angeles Times*.

KARL HESS—Hess left school at age 15 and went to work as a news writer for the Mutual Broadcasting System in Washington, D.C. He was an associate editor of "Newsweek" Magazine, wrote the 1960 Republican platform and served in the White House and Pentagon as special consultant to the president and Secretary of Defense, was Director of Special Projects at the American Enterprise Institute and Barry Goldwater's principal speechwriter in 1963.

RON HOLLAND—Account Executive with Interstate Securities Corporation, author of "The Threat to the Private Retirement System" and numerous articles on retirement planning and investments, a former bank vice president, trust department head and frequent speaker.

In "Investing For Personal & Financial Freedom," Holland will discuss the current investment situation and how to minimize the effects of government intervention in the economy, investment possibilities in the Turks and Caicos Islands and how to protect your I.R.A. and Retirement Plan from government takeover and control.

JOHN HOSPERS—is currently a USC professor of philosophy. Hospers ran for president of the U.S. on the Libertarian Party ticket in 1972. He is author of *Will Capitalism Survive?, Understanding the Arts, and Human Conduct*.

GARY C. HUDSON—Gary Hudson is the President and Chairman of Pacific American Launch Systems and has spent 15 years working, writing and lecturing in the field of commercial space with emphasis on private space transportation. Hudson designed the Percheron 055, the first private launcher in the U.S. Hudson has consulted to NASA, the University Space Research Organization and the National Space Development Agency of Japan and is past chairman of the Free Enterprise Committee of the Citizen's Advisory Council on National Space Policy, a Fellow of the British Interplanetary Society and a Senior Member of the American Astronautical Society. In "Space, Freedom's Final Frontier", Hudson's presentation will focus on the need for private access to the space frontier via commercial space transport vehicles.

JEFFREY ROGERS HUMMEL—Hummel is a free-

lance writer for *Reason, Inquiry, Journal of Libertarian Studies* and *Libertarian Review*. He graduated from the University of Texas at Austin where he did graduate work in economic history. Hummel is at work on *Denationalizing Defense: The Separation of Defense and State*.

DENNIS KAMENSKY—Kamensky holds an M.B.A. from Brooklyn College. He is author of *Winning On Your Income Taxes, Women and Taxes and The Tax File Organizer*, numerous articles and a weekly column in *The Oakland Tribune*. Dennis conducts workshops nationwide and produces tapes and has made public appearances on over 250 radio and T.V. shows with regular segments on CNN, "CBS Newsmakers", "AM Los Angeles" and "Eye On Washington".

SAMUEL E. KONKIN III—Konkin is editor of *New Libertarian* and a founder of the Agorist Institute. Konkin has organized half-a-dozen libertarian organization with the primary goal to attack the political activism, especially the Libertarian Party. He is author of *New Libertarian Manifesto*.

REGINA LIUDZIUS—Regina is an attorney specializing in business litigation. She was an intercollegiate debate champion and received her undergraduate degree (magna cum laude) and law degree from UCLA.

SPENCER MACCALLUM—MacCallum did his undergraduate work at Princeton University and later received his MA at the University of Washington in social anthropology. Director of the Heather Foundation, MacCallum has written one book entitled *The Art of Community*, which explores the field of proprietary communities.

JACK MATONIS—An attorney and former law professor, Matonis has fought government agencies for 20 years. In his last bout with the IRS, Matonis spent time in a federal prison.

RICHARD J. MAYBURY—An economist, Maybury's articles have appeared in the *Wall Street Journal, Washington Times, London Gold Forecast* and *World Market Perspective*. He has also written several books.

VINCENT MILLER—Miller is one of the founders of Libertarian International.

CAROL MOORE—An author and lecturer, Moore is active in libertarian, feminist, peace and disarmament, Green and bioregional and war tax resistance groups. She has been published in numerous publications.

TONIE NATHAN—Nathan is a media consultant, businesswoman, writer, speaker and former broadcaster and TV producer, author of *Libertarian Lady*, and *On Libertarianism*, and is the first and only woman to receive an electoral college vote as the Libertarian Party's candidate for U.S. Vice President in 1972.

DURK PEARSON & SANDY SHAW—Durk graduated from MIT in 1965 with degrees in physics, biology and psychology, founded Spectrum Technology Service, a scientific consulting business involved with the Gemini, Apollo, Viking, Pioneer, and Voyager projects, lasers, particle beams, satellite, energy and strategic nuclear deterrents, and holds several patents in energy conversion and production. Sandy graduated from UCLA in 1966 with a degree in chemistry and has been

scientific consultant to many companies. Together with Pearson, they co-authored the best-selling (became #1 on the New York Times list two weeks after publication, staying there for ten months, 2 million copies in print) *Life Extension: A Practical Scientific Approach* (Warner Brothers, 1982), *The Life Extension Companion* (Warner, 1984) and the recently published *The Life Extension Weight Loss Program* (Doubleday, 1986).

Pearson and Shaw will discuss how science and technology provide tools for increasing personal freedom; what's coming; closing in on the chemistry underlying obedience to authority; their personal secrets for maintaining privacy; latest research on weight control without hunger, calorie reduction or exercise; and how more people die each year awaiting FDA approval of drugs available in Europe for years than all war deaths since the Civil War.

ROBERT W. POOLE, JR.—Poole, the holder of two engineering degrees from MIT, is president of the Reason Foundation, a free-market oriented think tank. He serves as editor and publisher of *Reason Magazine*, authored *Cutting Back City Hall* and is editor of *Instead of Regulation, Defending A Free Society and Unnatural Monopolies*.

JOHN PUGSLEY—Pugsley is author of *Common Sense Economics* and *The Alpha Strategy* and is a well-known business consultant and publisher.

DICK RADFORD—A board member of Rampart Institute, Radford is the editor of *The Power of Congress*. He has written for *Common Sense* and other publications.

DANA ROHRBACHER—Mr. Rohrabacher holds a Masters Degree in American Studies at USC and is currently one of Ronald Reagan's five principal speechwriters, having travelled with him on the campaign trail in 1984, and former editorial writer for *The Orange County Register*. Rohrabacher was one of the organizers of the early Future of Freedom Conference series.

BUTLER SHAFFER—Shaffer has been a professor of law at Southwestern University of Law in Los Angeles since 1977. Shaffer is author of two books, *In Restraints of Trade: Business Attitudes Toward Competition and Regulation, 1918-1938* and *Calculated Chaos: The Institutional Causes of Social Conflict*.

LEE & JOYCE SHULMAN—Lee and Joyce Shulman are both in full-time private practice doing individual therapy, group therapy, marital and family therapy, psychological diagnostic evaluation, as well as supervising and training psychotherapists. Lee Shulman is co-author of *When to See A Psychologist*.

JAY SNELSON—Snelson is the Director and Founder of the Free Market Society, creator of the Human Action Seminars, a graduate of UCLA, lecturer, writer and educator.

Pearson & Shaw Accuse FDA of Crimes Against Humanity!

"double-blind" studies—i.e. studies in which some patients are given the drug being tested and some are given a placebo and neither doctors nor patients know which patients are getting which. This is a valuable procedure in some cases, since it provides some controls on psychosomatic reactions. Some diseases or conditions have a psychosomatic element to them, and some patients may respond to a placebo (typically a sugar pill) as they would to a genuinely effective drug.

However, Pearson and Shaw point out that in the case of AIDS, "the excuse that a double-blind placebo controlled trial is necessary won't hold water; full-blown AIDS is so deadly that there will be plenty of expert medical ethicists to testify that such a requirement is unnecessary, irrational, irresponsible and inhumane. There are already plenty of death statistics from untreated cases, and there is no reason to expect that a placebo effect will alter the outcome of such a lengthy disease. Plenty of placebo controlled studies have already shown no placebo curative abilities in AIDS."

As Durk and Sandy see it, the FDA has become so concerned with its control over access to drugs that they have forgotten about the suffering of terminally ill people. They are particularly shocked at one FDA officer, quoted in the Geiringer study, who reportedly said: "If you give in to the pressure [to make AIDS drugs available] how are you going to study the drugs? Pretty soon you can't do a study because no one wants one."

Durk and Sandy reply: "It is time to make a really big stink about this murderous FDA policy. The FDA has pretended for a long time that terminally ill people require the same protection

against new drugs as healthy people. What they refuse to recognize is that when there is little time left, you try the best of what is available, you can't wait for that perfect drug in the sky."

The two scientists hope to lead a brainstorming session on how to approach the FDA. Civil damage suits against FDA employees responsible for this policy or the FDA commissioner? Criminal charges? Conspiracy to deprive sick people of access to potentially life-saving drugs without due process? Class action suits? A grand jury investigation?

"The most important goal," they maintain, "is to get AIDS patients the opportunity to try new treatments. The FDA's disapproval of widespread 'compassionate use' in AIDS treatments has not and will not cure a single case of AIDS. The FDA seems prepared to follow its usual procedure of requiring elaborate 'proof' of efficacy and safety, while completely ignoring the lethal cost of their delays. Their view seems to be that it is better for 50,000 gays to die of AIDS than for one person to be harmed by the side effects of a drug they have not approved."

With increasing evidence from Africa and Haiti as well as new evidence emerging in the United States, that AIDS is not a "gay disease" at all, but can afflict children and heterosexuals to the same deadly effect, this is an issue that should concern all Americans. If the government agency charged with protecting our health and safety is more concerned about performing certain kinds of tests in the prescribed bureaucratic manner than about thousands of people dying a slow and unpleasant death while they fiddle in Washington, the world is indeed turned upside down.

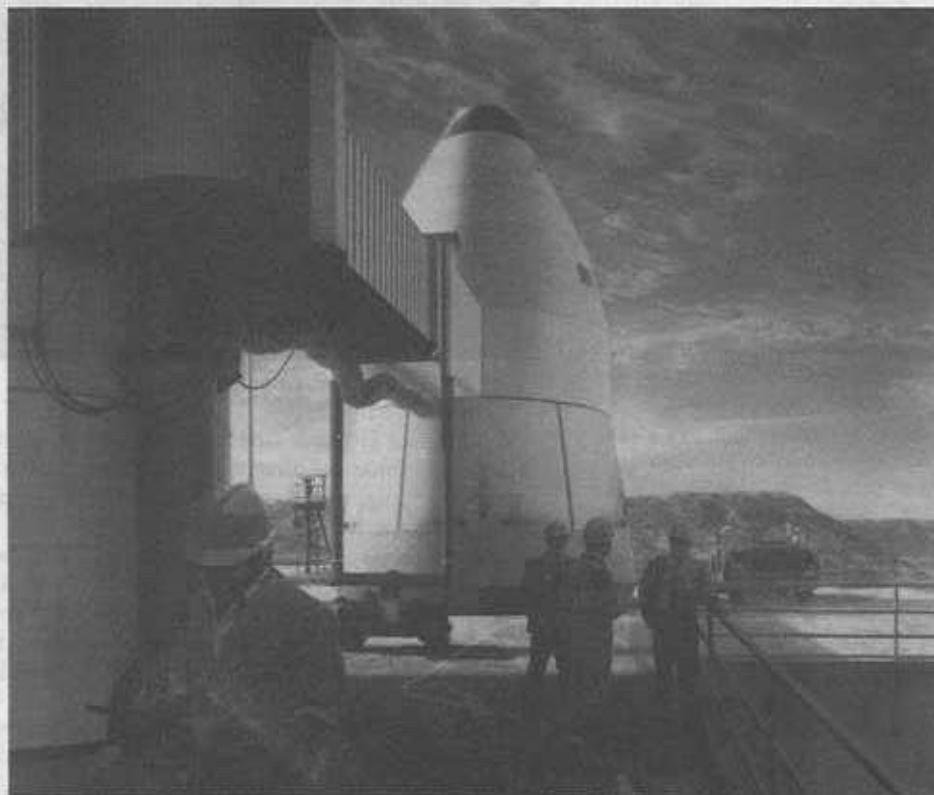

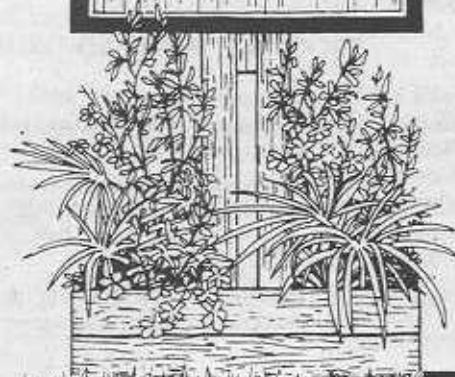
