SHORT HISTORY OF SOCIETY FOR LIBERTARIAN LIFE

First organized under the name of Students for Libertarian Life in 1973 at California State University, Fullerton, **Society for Libertarian Life** has grown beyond one campus. Now with chapters on other colleges as well as in the community, SLL continues to be a leader in libertarian thinking and activity.

The momentum began to build for **SLL** in 1976 with a lecture by Dr. Nathaniel Branden, a former associate of the novelist Ayn Rand. Despite a small mailing list of under 100, SLL send out invitations to Branden's lecture which resulted in an audience of more than 300 persons. With Branden's success to build on, **SLL** began a series of lectures by Prof. Tibor Machan, Karl Bray, Prof. Murray Rothbard, Prof. John Hospers, Prof. Charles Baird, Robert LeFevre, John Matonis, John Pugsley, Kenneth Grubbs, Jr., David Bergland, Sy Leon and others

The next project of SLL was to develop a larger catalog of educational materials which includes: buttons, booklets, posters, adhesive stickers and position papers. The catalog provides over half the revenue of **SLL's** budget.

The main purpose of **SLL** is stated in the **Libertas Statement** which was written in 1973 and up-dated a few years later. Since **SLL** is an affiliate of CSUF Associated Students, Inc., donations may be used as tax deductions. Donations are always appreciated and help to promote libertarianism on the campus and in the community.

The organization is governed by Directors and an Executive Board.

A more detailed history of **SLL** can be found in the back section of Robert LeFevre's *Does Government Protection Protect?* which was published in May, 1979. Copies sell for \$2.50 each.
