

THE PHILOSOPHY

IF THERE was ever a philosophy that could change the world, it would have to be libertarianism. The reason is clear. It is basically the first philosophy which states that man is the sole owner of himself, that if man does not own himself he is therefore a slave. And because of this basic idea, libertarianism began as an alliance of liberals and conservatives who both agreed that there must be economic freedom as well as moral freedom for man to be considered his own master.

Libertarianism also advocates that the sole right of man is that he be left unmolested. That is all unconsented aggression is immoral. Therefore all initiated aggression is immoral whether it be taxation or the censorship of so-called dirty books. In the tradition of Jefferson, the libertarian is both an individualist and a voluntarist.
